



MARYLAND MUST NOT BECOME A HAVEN FOR ABORTIONISTS WHO KILL VIABLE BABIES WHO FEEL PAIN!

The lack of protective regulation of abortion in Maryland threatens to make our state a haven for out-of-state abortionists and abortion practitioners who specialize in aborting babies in the second half of pregnancy, when unborn babies are capable of experiencing terrible pain and many would be able to survive if born and given appropriate care.

We, the undersigned, are concerned that abortion in the last half of pregnancy poses a grave threat to women's health. We believe the State should regulate abortion to protect women and to prevent Maryland from becoming a haven for abortionists. Collecting data on the incidence of abortion, requiring abortion facilities to adhere to the same medical standards as other ambulatory surgery facilities, limiting taxpayer funding of abortion, promoting abortion alternatives, and restricting abortion after fetal viability are reasonable regulations that the State should consider.

We call on Maryland public officials to keep Maryland from becoming a haven for out-of-state abortionists seeking to circumvent abortion laws in their own states.
