



WE URGE MARYLAND ELECTED OFFICIALS TO SUPPORT ULTRASOUND LEGISLATION

At least 16 states now require abortion providers to give women the opportunity to view a sonogram image before an abortion. Such bills are intended to ensure that women have access to full information before making a decision with potentially life-changing consequences. Some women who choose abortion later regret their decision. Sonogram bills are intended to help women who might make a different choice after viewing an ultrasound. An attempt to pass sonogram legislation in the 2009 Legislative Assembly failed in committee. We support legislation in Maryland to require women seeking abortion to be given the option to view a sonogram if they wish.
