■ **Abortion Without Limits:** The "Women's Health Protection Act" (WHPA) is a bill in Congress which would remove virtually all legal protections for unborn children on the federal and state level, and prevent future protections for unborn children. If elected, Alsobrooks has pledged to cosponsor this legislation on her first day in office.

When asked by reporters if there is any point in pregnancy when she believes unborn children should be protected from abortion, Alsobrooks answered, "**No. I believe the decision belongs to a woman and her doctor.**" (Fox News, May 24, 2024)

■ **The Senate Filibuster:** Alsobrooks has called for eliminating Senate filibuster rules in order to circumvent the 60-vote threshold currently required to pass legislation like the WHPA. "**As Maryland's next Senator, I will not let the filibuster impede my work. I will vote to codify abortion rights,**" she posted on X. (May 28, 2024)

■ **Funding Abortion Providers:** Alsobrooks supports the use of taxpayer dollars to fund organizations that perform abortions like Planned Parenthood, the nation's largest chain of abortion clinics. On her Senate campaign website, she described efforts to redirect family planning funds to community health centers as "**misguided.**"

■ **Endorsements:** Alsobrooks is endorsed by groups that support unlimited abortion like Planned Parenthood Action Fund, EMILY's List, and Reproductive Freedom for All. "**Angela Alsobrooks is the candidate we need in the Senate to protect and expand reproductive freedom,**" the CEO of Reproductive Freedom for All argued in a press release. (May 15, 2024)

■ **Chemical Abortions:** Maryland is not required to report complications that occur as a result of taking the abortion drug mifepristone. Without supporting data, Alsobrooks defended mifepristone, calling it "**safe and effective**" in a post on X. "**In a post-Dobbs world, it's crucial we defend access to this important medication,**" she added. (May 28, 2024)

■ **Judicial Nominees:** Alsobrooks vows that she will "**oppose any judicial nominee who does not support abortion rights.**" In 2022, Alsobrooks praised the appointment of Ketanji Brown-Jackson to the U.S. Supreme Court. Jackson's nomination was supported by the nation's leading pro-abortion groups.

■ **Court Packing:** At a March 2024 press conference, a Reproductive Freedom for All spokesperson told reporters, "**We know (Alsobrooks) will never stop fighting for abortion rights and access, and we know we can count on her to help lead the charge for court reform and expansion.**"
